



GIRL SCOUT HISTORY COMES ALIVE

Juliette's Place Tour and Tea Party

Juliette's Place is the home of the archive collection of Girl Scouts of Citrus Council, and is housed in the first floor of the two-story house next to the covered parking. Tea Parties are provided for small groups of girls by the Archive Team volunteers at a fee of \$5 per girl – includes special Juliette's Tea Party patch. Two adults are free and each additional adult is \$2. Programs are provided on Wednesdays after school (you must arrive by 3:30 p.m.) or on school holidays depending on the availability of the Archive Team (must be a day the Council office is open). Depending on the number of girls, age level and their interest, the activity will take 1½-2 hours. Because of space restrictions, we must limit the number of participants to 12 (girls and adults).



The volunteers will work with you to tailor the activity to the age and interest of your troop. The girls tour Juliette's Place and learn about the Girl Scout Historical Collection that we have and how to care for these items. The girls are then allowed to dress in a uniform from the past and go to the Third Floor of the Service Center to view the exhibits. In the Board Room they are treated to a formal tea party, as well as one or two other activities. In this unique setting, girls learn about the legacy Juliette Low left to the girls of the United States and the entire world.

You may email or call about the availability, but the reservation form must be received two weeks prior to the date. Your date will not be confirmed until the form is received in the Council office. You will receive an email confirmation if your date is available. Juliette's Legacy Traveling Trunks

Another program available for girls interested in learning more about the history of Girl Scouts and Juliette Low was created by the Archive Team. Our "Traveling Trunks" program allows girls to learn about Juliette's Legacy. The "Traveling Trunks" contain a variety of handbooks, uniforms and a guidebook full of activities that a troop can do to complete this Juliette's Legacy patch. We hope that troops will enjoy delving deeper into the history of Girl Scouting as we move into the second 100 years of Girl Scouting. A patch is available for purchase from the Council Shop. The "trunks" will be available for checkout at the Council Service Center but need to be reserved in advance. There is a \$10 per "trunk" fee to borrow one of the "Traveling Trunks." When the trunk is returned, if there are any missing or damaged items, there could be an additional \$20 fee to replace those items. Normally a trunk may be kept for two to three weeks.
